SURPRISE! SANDI AND LARNELLE SHARE TOP DOVE AWARD HONORS

NASHVILLE, Tenn.--Sandi Patti and Larnelle Harris shared top honors at the Gospel Music Association's 19th Annual Dove Awards on April 14, picking up three awards apiece. Harris won three of a potential five Doves while Patti was three for three. She was named Artist of the Year for the fifth time in the last seven years and Female Vocalist for the seventh year in a row. Patti also won a Dove as co-writer of the Song of the Year, "In the Name of the Lord."

Harris was named Male Vocalist of the Year and Songwriter of the Year while *The Father Hath Provided* was named Inspirational Album of the Year.

For the second year in a row, First Call received the award for Group of the Year. The Cathedrals also reprised last year's win in the Southern Gospel Album of the Year category for their 1987 album, *Symphony of Praise*.

Wayne Watson picked up his first Dove for his album *Watercolour Ponies*, which was named Contemporary Album of the Year. *Crack the Sky* by Mylon LeFevre & Broken Heart repeated its recent Grammy win by being chosen as Rock Album of the Year. BeBe and CeCe Winans, who received five nominations, won the Horizon Award for new artists. A complete list of Dove Award winners appears on page 3.

"THE STATE OF CHRISTIAN RADIO:" WILL IT FAIL OR WILL IT FLY?

NASHVILLE, Tenn.--Those in attendance at the April 11 "State of Christian Radio" address at the National Christian Radio Seminar were thrown some rather mixed signals. Speaker Brad Burkhart began the session by stating, "I am convinced that Christian radio will die in the next 10 years. I think for those with eyes open, the warning signs are all around." He then explained the basis of his convictions and outlined a plan to avoid disaster. On the other hand, he repeatedly referred to Christian radio as being "very healthy."

Three particular problems were held as contributing factors to this apparent sorry state of affairs. Primary among those was the fact that stations are allowing "short term economic payoffs" to supersede long term goals. Also, the industry on the whole was cited as being too reliant on major artists to sell records. Lastly, it was revealed that the correlation between a station's facility and its ratings is becoming more apparent. Where in the past the sought-after contemporary Christian music format could survive in spite of its facility, "it is now becoming increasingly

difficult, even for specialized programming, to attract a large audience on the AM dial."

In more general terms, a few more reasons were given as to why "Christian radio will fail in the next 10 years." A negative attitude was cited as the industry's primary downfall. To counteract this negativism, Burkhart used the analogy of a child learning to walk. "We are a very young industry," he said. "I've never heard of a child that didn't fall several times before they took their first step."

A "compromised focus" was noted as another barrier the Christian radio industry needs to hurdle. "We need to be narrow in focus," stated Burkhart. "If there are blocks of our programming that are committed to attracting one demographic, then we are foolish to chase off that demo with the music we are playing. We are not building a cohesive unit." Burkhart then

BENSON COMPANY DECIDES TO DROP SWAGGART DISTRIBUTION

NASHVILLE, Tenn.--The management of the Zondervan Music Group announced last week that it has decided to discontinue its distribution agreement with Jim Records and Shiloh Records, both of which are divisions of Jimmy Swaggart Ministries. In a carefully worded statement, Jerry Park, general manager and chief operating officer of The Benson Company, said the move was made "in light of certain decisions made and actions taken by Jimmy Swaggart Ministries."

Just over two weeks ago, Jimmy Swaggart announced that he would not submit to the disciplinary requirements of the national leaders of the Assemblies of God regarding his recently revealed moral failure and was consequently dismissed from the church. He resigned in turn.

Retailers have approximately 30 days to return product to Benson if they so choose, and Benson will continue selling Jim and Shiloh product during that period, although not actively.

When contacted by *The CCM Update*, Donnie Swaggart said that a tentative distribution agreement with another company had been reached prior to Benson's decision. "A statement will be forthcoming from all parties involved," he said.

Park indicated that the staff at Jimmy Swaggart Ministries has been "very cooperative" during this time. "Our hopes and prayers are with the people at Jimmy Swaggart Ministries as they work through this challenging period."

OUT AND ABOUT...

* The preview party for **Amy Grant's** new album appeared to be quite a success. Three busloads of delighted NCRS attendees were greeted personally by Amy as they arrived at her farm for their two-hour foray. The approximately 150 guests were allowed to roam freely throughout the house as a buffet dinner was served outside. Later, five of the new album's 12 songs were played from a digital copy and introduced by Amy. The cuts played included "1974," "Saved by Love," "What About the Love?," "If These Walls Could Speak," and the title track, "Lead Me On." **NCRA** president **Joe Battaglia** presented Amy with a plaque as an expression of gratitude for the contribution her music has made to Christian radio. However, the preview party was clearly intended to signal one message to radio programmers: Amy is back! And after listening to the entire album several times, we can confidently say that it represents a new level of artistic achievement. We'll save the rest of our accolades for the review page, but we can't resist one editorial comment: Christian radio will be the better for playing this music. The first single should be released in about a month, to be followed by the album in late June...

* **Steve Taylor** came up with quite a surprise for his concert opener at The Cannery during **GMA Week**. Remember the operatic opening of "Harder to Believe Than Not To?" As the lights came up at the beginning of his set, none other than **Sandi Patti** did the vocal honors on the song. She and Taylor performed together along with a string quartet. It was something to see (and hear!). By the way, Taylor's forthcoming / *Predict 1990* "Video Album" will retail for the clever price of \$19.90...

* While on the subject of prices, retailers should note that **Sparrow/Star Song Distribution** lowered the price of all **Meadowlark** compact discs to \$11.98 effective April 1. A 45% discount is available to retailers on a 30-piece minimum order...

* The **Recording Industry Association of America** (RIAA) has designated the name "CD³" for the three-inch compact disc. The RIAA marketing committee has also determined an industry standard for packaging--3" X 7" for the CD³ single, which will contain two cuts and 3" X 12" for the CD³ maxi which will have more than two cuts (or extended plays). The new format will also carry a special logo...

* **Miami Steve Van Zandt** will produce the new **Dion** album for Arista...

* **The Zondervan Corporation** appears to be a takeover target once again. Our Wall Street sources say that Zondervan management has received an acquisition proposal of \$70 million for approximately 5.8 million shares (\$12/share) from undisclosed buyers. The rumor is that the potential buyer is Nashville-based **Wolgemuth & Hyatt Publishers**, which is a little like Jonah swallowing the whale. Well, David *did* slay Goliath, so maybe these guys have a shot. Persistent talk is that any buyer will quickly sell off various divisions of Zondervan, including the music group--which includes **The Benson Company**...

PETRA, NELSON PACT FOR "TRANSFORMER"

NASHVILLE, Tenn.--In what must certainly be a first, the world's leading Bible publisher has signed a Christian rock group to endorse a Bible version. Beginning in July, Petra will exclusively endorse "The Transformer," Thomas Nelson's most popular youth Bible. The announcement was made at a press conference held April 11 during GMA Week.

"Nelson is committed to expanding its outreach by placing the word of God in the hands of today's youth," said Nelson executive vice president Charles Moore. "This is a major concern of Petra, whose ministry is also Bible-based."

Petra founder Bob Hartman said, "The Transformer" deals with a lot of critical issues that Petra is concerned with... issues that we want to--and do--address in our ministry."

Nelson plans to kick off this association with a Petra concert at the Reunion Arena in Dallas during

the 1988 CBA Convention. The company will also co-sponsor the broadcast of Petra's July 31 concert at "D.C. '88" in Washington, D.C.

Petra will offer "The Transformer" at concerts and through their newsletter.

PATTI TO ENDORSE KINGDOM RESORT

NASHVILLE, Tenn.--Sandi Patti has signed a personal endorsement agreement with Kingdom Resort, a 125-acre hotel/entertainment complex in Pigeon Forge, TN. The 12-month agreement, which was announced during GMA Week, is effective immediately. It calls for Patti to act as official "goodwill ambassador" for the Resort, which serves as one location for The Great Passion Play produced by the Elna M. Smith Foundation of Eureka Springs, AR.

Terms of the agreement include Patti's verbal endorsement of the Resort during concert appearances within a 500-mile radius of the Resort, appearances in Kingdom

Resort television commercials, and a series of live performances in the Resort's 4,000-seat amphitheatre. She will also be featured at the grand opening festivities for the complex June 4-5.

"We are delighted that an artist of Sandi's calibre has joined in our vision of providing positive, high-quality entertainment in a Christian setting," said Ed Neely, co-owner of Kingdom Resort.

BROKEN & WHITE HEART TO ATTACK

NASHVILLE, Tenn.--Mylon & Broken Heart and White Heart announced during GMA Week that the two Christian rock bands will tour together this fall. The tour, dubbed "Heart Attack '88," marks the first time the two groups--each headliners in their own right--have combined forces.

The 30-city tour will concentrate on the midwest and eastern U.S., including Atlanta, Nashville, Pittsburgh, Minneapolis, and Denver. Plans include a west coast leg in the spring of '89.

went on to stress long-term format commitment, stating that it generally takes a radio audience nine months to perceive a programming change.

Finally, Burkhart felled the fallacy that people involved in Christian radio are more committed because of their "mission" than their secular counterparts. "I know very few secular programmers that are not more committed in their mission, and their purpose, and their propaganda, than we are in ours."

To support his counterclaim that "Christian radio is very healthy," Burkhart stated that "during the last 12 months no format has seen the proportion of percentage of growth than the contemporary Christian format has." As another sign that the format is healthy, the fact was brought to light that while on the whole religious radio is skewing older, a significant number of stations are reaching the much-coveted 25-44, or baby-boomer, demographic.

In summation, Burkhart attempted to rally the approximate 200 in attendance by remarking, "We're young and healthy, but we've also been through a pretty harsh last two and a half years. We're at a period where we probably have three or four years that will determine whether we'll be here in 10 years. I think we're going to succeed. I think that we need to do that with these problems clearly in mind."

Trace Balin, *Champion* (DaySpring)

Here's an impressive debut from an up-and-comer from Florida. A former ABC Records recording artist, she was introduced to Christian music on Wayne Watson's *Watercolour Ponies* album. Balin blends her gutsy vocal delivery (at times reminiscent of Heart's Ann Wilson) and catchy songs with hooks galore to produce solid pop music with a light rock feel. "We Need Each Other" features Balin with Bob Carlisle of Allie and Marty McCall of First Call.

Steve Camp, *Compact Favorites* (Sparrow)

A compilation of 10 of Camp's hard-hitting, call-to-holiness songs, from *Fire and Ice*, *Shake Me to Wake Me*, and *One on One*. CD only. \$11.98 retail.

Debbie McMurray, *The Best Years Are Ahead* (McTree)

This independent artist presents the right ingredients for a good album—good vocals, good production, good arrangements. She sings nice, accessible pop songs patterned after Top 40 radio. This is a well-rounded debut from an artist with national potential.

Rez, *Compact Favorites* (Sparrow)

Ten solid rock songs from the pioneers who played hard rock before it was popular. From the albums *Between Heaven and Hell*, *Hostage*, and *Live—Bootleg*. An added bonus is a live medley that features songs from their early Star Song albums. CD only. \$11.98 retail.

Arthur Scales, *I'm Just Passin' Through* (I Am)

This debut release features instrumental songs featuring Scales' sax and vocal songs featuring Scales' voice, and he shines in both roles. Scales' expert work on the sax varies from exuberant to soulful. Should appeal to the black and white markets alike.

Solvei and Judi, *Praising You* (Fortress)

These two ladies' beautiful vocal blend and touching songs of praise contribute to a strong offering for the inspirational market. Produced by Harlan Rogers and accompanied by Koinonia, perhaps this release will start a new category of music called "pretty praise" music.

Terry Talbot, *Terry Talbot* (Live Oak)

This represents a debut album for Christian music veteran Talbot. It is a debut with a new record company, but it also debuts a new sound. Talbot adopts a grittier, rockier sound, and an intensity of passion not heard from him in years. "Battle Hymn" is a stirring anthem about persecuted Christians in the Third World. Produced by Dan Collins.

Various Artists, *The Electric Praise Album* (Fortress)

Even though this release features upbeat, catchy praise tunes and an impressive roster (Darrell Mansfield, Kelly Willard, Alwyn Wall, and Malcolm Wilde), it is a bit disappointing. The poor production value and at times overly repetitive choruses give the impression of an album not reaching its potential. However, its mid-'70s quality is so reminiscent of early Maranatha! praise albums and groups, it may appeal to boomers yearning for a simpler time.

Sheila Walsh, *Compact Favorites* (Sparrow)

A best-of collection of 10 songs from the *War of Love*, *Triumph in the Air*, *Don't Hide Your Heart*, and *Future Eyes* albums. For fans of the early Walsh new wave sound. CD only. \$11.98 retail.

Title cuts from the two debut projects from the new Diadem Music label. "Outside These Walls," finds Lamb encouraging believers in their Monday thru Saturday walk, while the B-side has Rios covering a song which Debby Boone did on her *With My Song...* LP --an adaptation in song of the Apostles' and Nicene Creed. Joseph Lamm, "Awaken in My Heart" (HMS)

No formula here. This inventive first release shows exemplary production and intriguing open form instrumentation, while lyrical bent shows a no-compromise biblical base. 805/942-7108

Marvin & Gentry, "Safe Harbour," b/w "Take Me Back" (M&H)

This singer-songwriter duo remains in an acoustic-cum-America mode on this third single release from the *Safe Harbour* LP. The title cut is a refreshing sea-faring story of refuge in Jesus, while "Take Me Back" adds a pedal steel for a country-flavored testimony of the joy of spiritual youth.

CHART WATCH

Adult Contemporary

The competition is intense. While Sandi Patti's "Make His Praise Glorious" does hold on to the top position, Geoff Moore's "Heart and Soul" is a mere 19 points behind, and actually has three more stations reporting the cut. "Friend in You" by Jon Gibson is also in the thick of it with one more individual report than "Make His Praise Glorious," and only 80 fewer points. Kim Boyce's "You Can Be Mine" is a distant fifth, but takes that position after only four weeks on the chart and with a nine-position jump. Other prime movers include Sheila Walsh's "Jesus Loves the Church," up 12 to #6, and "Again and Again," by Mylon and Broken Heart, up 14 to #12. Reunion Records artists hold the highest two debuts—Rick Cua's "Forever Yours" at #19, and new artist Kim Hill's "Faithful" at #21.

Inspirational

The point margin between "Make His Praise Glorious" and "Sing Over Me" has changed greatly since last period's "photo-finish." Nearly 100 points separate the two this time out as Sandi Patti's title cut from her latest release moves to the top position. Buddy Greene's "Virtuous Woman" and Jon Gibson's "Friend in You" jump 5 & 6 positions respectively to settle within the top 10. "One Faith" by John Michael Talbot represents this period's highest debut at #15, while the group who gave us a metal version of Larry Norman's classic "Why Should the Devil Have All the Good Music?" a couple years back, enters at #21 with "Heart and Soul." New artist Kim Hill debuts on the *Most Active* chart.

Contemporary Hits

"Heart and Soul" slightly increases its spread over second place, as Carman's "Radically Saved!" surrenders that position to "Friend in You" by Jon Gibson. "I Believe in You" climbs four to #5, as last week's big upward mover—"Stand" by DeGarmo & Key—drops seven places to #13. The volatility of this format is reflected in the fact that no song has been on the chart for more than six weeks.

Rock

The top three remain unchanged as "A Place to Stand" by Geoff Moore & the Distance holds on to #1 with 50 points to spare — this despite the fact that White Heart's "More Sold Out" finished with more individual reports. Mad at the World's "Flowers in the Rain" looks to have high intentions after it moves up five placements to #4 after only four charting weeks. This period's prime movers are Mylon & Broken Heart's "Won by One" (up 14) and Steve Taylor's "I Blew Up the Clinic Real Good" (up 11). Russ Taff's "Shake" notches its 14th week in the top 10 as "(Living on the) Edge of Time" enters at #22 for the passing of the torch.

Video Airplay

This chart has held pretty steady over the last month, with the exception of Bash-N-the Code's "B-I-B-L-E" moving up eight positions to #1. "Love God, Hate Sin" drops to #2 after topping the chart for the previous two months. While Stryper flourishes on secular video shows, their clip "Honestly" fell off this consensus of Christian video programs.
