MYRRH "GOES FOR THE GOLD" WITH NEW AMY GRANT CAMPAIGN

LOS ANGELES, Calif.--They're calling it "a golden opportunity," and amidst a flurry of fanfare, it's finally happening. The newest Amy Grant album, *Lead Me On*, is being marketed to retailers and radio, and is receiving the enthusiastic response Word, and the rest of the market, has been anticipating.

"We've not had this kind of reception to a campaign before," said Word Vice President of Marketing Loren Balman. "I'd say we will probably--from the looks of things--ship more of this than anything we've ever shipped before."

More than ever, in this case, means probable gold shipment (500,000 units). "If we *do* ship gold, it'll be a first in Christian music," according to Balman. So far orders are meeting those expectations. Word's sales reps began their eight-week cycle of sales the first week of May, in time to wrap it up just prior to the album's June 28 street date.

The bulk of the promotion revolves around the Limited Edition Amy Grant Gold Signature Disc, the record industry's first 24K Gold CD. Each disc, plated in a fine reflective layer of gold, has a four-color image of Grant, and will be signed with a custom ink by Amy herself. 2,000 of the discs will be won by consumers in Christian bookstores (every 250th CD will be gold), and 250 will be awarded through 95 radio outlets.

Retailers can expect a variety of perks with the promotion. A counter display will allow customers to pre-order *Lead Me On*. A gravity-fed display ("the first for pre-recorded product anywhere," Balman said) will hold almost \$800 worth of cassettes and CDs. The display allows an upper layer of product to drop down when the customer pulls a unit from the bottom. For visual appeal, lifesized full-color stand-ups of Grant will be shipped to stores and will be available for use in give-aways, photo opportunities, etc.

What's more, any retailer ordering 500 units or more will be presented with a *Lead Me On* gold album engraved with the buyer's or the store's name. The award will be RIAA-certified.

Radio has its own promotions going. The album's first single, "Saved by Love," is being shipped this week on CD (with this issue of *The Update*) and vinyl, and stations nationwide are gearing up with promotions surrounding and/or including the gold CD giveaways. Monument, Co.'s KKRE is planning the "Amy Grant Gold Rush," which Hauser calls "a very intense, pretty intricate promotion." Local jewelers are trading out for gold necklaces to be given away; extra advertisers are

being brought in just for the promotion, and a CD player will be presented with the gold CD.

WBRG/Lynchburg and KOJO/Dallas are having similar "treasure hunt" promotions, with the gold CDs being hid in the cities and clues given on the air as to their whereabouts.

Myrrh is asking stations to conduct promotions between the release of "Saved by Love" and the album itself.

"This album is important," says Chris Hauser of Myrrh radio promotions. "It's meant a lot to me. There's a tenderness in the songs on the album that I've never heard [from Grant] before, especially in her love for Gary. I'm saying to radio guys, 'Just wait to be as moved by it as I have been.'"

"CARRY THE LIGHT" DEBUTS AT 'WASHINGTON FOR JESUS'

WASHINGTON, D.C.--"Carry the Light," the official theme song of Target 2000: The Great Commission Torch Run, was premiered before more than 250,000 people who gathered on the mall in Washington D.C. April 28 to participate in Washington for Jesus.

Twila Paris, who wrote the song especially for the Lausanne Committee for World Evangelism, taught the song to the audience before being joined on stage by Sheila Walsh, Scott Wesley Brown, Joe English, Jessy Dixon, Terry Talbot, and Melody Green.

Loren Cunningham, Lausanne Committee member and Youth With a Mission founder brought the presentation to a climax when he brought to the stage the original torch which was lit on the Mount of Olives Easter Sunday and transported, still ablaze, to the United States by military carrier. Relay teams coordinated by YWAM will carry hand-held torches symbolizing the gospel of Christ around the world. The torch which was brought to Washington was used to light four other torches whose destinations include Australia, Europe and other locations within the U.S.

A video of "Carry the Light" is being produced by the Christian Broadcasting Network and Dupree Productions. Included will be footage of the original torch lighting, the Washington for Jesus concert and the song's Nashville recording sessions. Produced by Jonathan David Brown, the song features artists including Steve Green, Larnelle Harris, Michael W. Smith, The Bill Gaither Trio, Steve Camp, Mylon LeFevre, DeGarmo & Key, Dallas Holm, BeBe & CeCe Winans, Wayne Watson, First Call, John Schlitt of Petra, Margaret Becker, Take 6 and Sharon Batts of "Dear Mr. Jesus."

LAGUNA HILLS, Calif.--A panel of writers, critics, editors and contributors to CCM magazine has voted Larry Norman's 1972 classic *Only Visiting This Planet* as the best contemporary Christian album of all time. Norman also produced three of the top albums. Top producer was Jonathan David Brown, with four albums in the top 25. The poll appears in CCM's June issue in conjunction with the magazine's 10th anniversary.

FCCM CONFERENCE SET FOR AUGUST

ARLINGTON HEIGHTS, IL--The Fellowship of Contemporary Christian Ministries (FCCM) will hold its 13th annual national conference August 22-26 in Flat Rock, NC. Utilizing the theme "Ministering to the MTV Generation," the conference will focus on the changing face of ministry in the television/video age, effective methods for reaching today's generation, and more.

The annual event--which offers dozens of workshops as well as teaching and fellowship-- draws musicians, youth workers, performing artists, writers, songwriters, concert and festival promoters and others.

Speakers include author/teacher Winkie Pratney of Youth Aflame, whose theme for the week is "Welcome to the Nightmare: Big Brother's Children in the 1980s" and Gary Zelesky of Z-Force Ministries on "High School Evangelism: Master Plan for the 1990s."

Steve Rabey, editor of *Compassion Update* and author of *The Heart of Rock 'n' Roll*, will deliver the keynote address. He will also teach a workshop entitled "Writing to the MTV Generation."

PICK OF THE WEEK:**Steve Green, *Find Us Faithful*** (Sparrow)

Green gets better with each album, as he seems to be more comfortable with the material each time. Green's sterling vocals complement the big majestic numbers as well as the soft, intimate songs on this his sixth project. Although the music is a slight bit more contemporary, it still represents a stellar Greg Nelson production job guaranteed to adorn AC and inspirational formats nationwide.

The Barrett Sisters, *I've Got a Feeling* (I Am)

These three sisters cover gospel songs and hymns with contemporary flair on this debut release. The producers resisted overproduction, although it lacks at times. The sisters prove their versatility vocally as a harmonious vocal group and competent soloists, and with their songs ranging from funk to Southern gospel to ballads.

The Bowker Brothers, *Joyful* (Harvest Music)

These two musicians skillfully blend their piano playing on this instrumental release of sacred classical compositions and traditional and contemporary hymns. Occasional orchestral and electronic touches. Lyrics included.

People of Destiny, *Arise and Worship* (Diadem)

This welcome addition to the praise music field combines worship songs featuring contemporary arrangements with a light rock feel. Produced by Bob Kauflin of Glad fame. From the People of Destiny Ministry (Larry Tomczak and C.J. Mahaney). *Arise*, along with Maranatha's Vineyard releases, may create a new music category: yuppie praise. Available in regular stereo cassette release and a split track version. The CD contains both. Songbook also available.

Sandi Rios, *Lord I Believe* (Diadem)

Rios' debut release highlights her excellent vocal abilities. The songs (from Cloninger, Borop, Smiley, Rios, and others) are a straight-ahead pop and AC mix (an upbeat Sandi Patti), featuring top Nashville players and background vocals by First Call. Rios sings a duet with Gaither Vocal Band member Mike English on "I'm Goin' Home."

Stevie and the Saints, *Metal Blue* (Victoria Ltd.)

This three-man band's git-down, boogie, raucous roll would be equally comfortable in a garage or bar. This eight-song release features good musicianship, simple songs ("We Are the Saints," "Code Name Jesus," "Don't Knock the Rock," etc.) and Southern influence from ZZ Top, the Fabulous Thunderbirds, and Allman Brothers. Reminiscent of the zeal and production of early Christian rock. Fun stuff.

Greg X. Volz, *Come Out Fighting* (Myrrh)

Come Out Fighting, rather than focusing on negating Volz's past with Petra (which *The River Is Rising* found him doing), accentuates Volz's well-known assets --an amazing and exhilarating vocal range and a penchant for pop/rock songs with military metaphors --and delivers a stronger effort. The arrangements put the focus on the hooky memorability of the chorus and Volz's unique vocal abilities. While *Fighting* will not overwhelm Volz's fans, they'll be glad to have him back in true form. --Brian Quincy Newcomb

Karen Wheaton, *Know My Heart* (LifeStream)

This Alabama native debuts her strong, confident alto vocals on this Nashville-produced release. A pleasing variety of inspirational and light AC songs with background vocals by First Call. Wheaton is widely known for her solo performances at various Christian crusades and seminars, as well as extensive personal touring.

PICK OF THE WEEK:**Amy Grant, "Saved By Love"** (Myrrh) CD

It's here! The debut release from Grant's long-anticipated *Lead Me On* project speaks of sustaining love --love for family, and love for Christ. Mid-tempo instrumentation features mandolin and acoustic piano, paced by a gentle drum clip. It's satisfying melodic pop with heart.

Randy Stonehill, "Coming Back Soon," b/w "Brighter Day" (Myrrh) 12"

"Coming Back Soon" is the classic Stonehill ballad. A personal glimpse into the artist's life as he uses his relationship with his daughter to try and understand God's relationship to His children. "Brighter Day" is a storming acoustic rocker utilizing the wrenching BGVs of Gary Chapman --call it Power Twang.

Adam Again, "Trouble with Lies" (Broken)

Infectious funk groove carries a seering treatise on deceit --both on a personal and national scale. Gene Eugene's brooding vocal blends with an active BGV unit, superior instrumentation and production for a top-notch dance/rock release.

Debby Boone, "Masihlangerani" (Lamb & Lion) *Compilation CD*

Inventive instrumentation (and lyrics) create an upbeat setting as Boone and guest male vocalists encourage Christian unity.

Michael Card, "That's What Faith Must Be" (Sparrow)

Engaging first release from Card's *Present Reality* employs a simple tune in a biblically-based description of faith. Tempered acoustic piano and guitar work reinforce the thoughtful nature of the cut.

Bruce Carroll, "Something Good is Bound to Happen" (New Canaan)

Pleasant story-song about patience and the reasons behind the artist's positive attitude. Galloping beat and melodic guitar lead sustain a mid-pace.

First Call, "O Sifuni Mungu" (DaySpring)

It was just a matter of time before the now-popular African influences on modern music would touch the mainstream Christian market. "O Sifuni Mungu" is the real thing --incorporating the contributions of two Swahili tribesmen and the vocal virtuosity of First Call (with some help from David Maddux on bass) for a distinctive Christian radio release.

Renee Garcia, "I Want to Be Used for You," b/w "The Bounce" (Reunion)

"I Want to Be Used for You" uplifts with its testimony of surrender, and soothes with mood-setting modern synth production. "The Bounce" provides the upbeat flare the title promises with its percussive instrumentation and dance beat.

Bobby Michaels, "Anything That Costs Me Nothing" (Word)

Inspirational offering testifies to total surrender. Dynamic orchestration supports an impassioned vocal.

Phil & John, "Over the Moon" (DaySpring International)

Singing/songwriting duo Phil & John brings its British brand of Christian pop to American radio with this debut cut from the *Lonely Dancer* LP. Laid-back production incorporates keys and an occasional lilting flute with a story of commitment and forgiveness.

Greg X. Volz, "Take Me to the End," b/w "I Come Out Fighting" (Myrrh) 12"

Volz seems much more comfortable with his post-Petra role on this debut release from the upcoming *Come Out Fighting* LP. "Take Me..." is a song of renewal meshing a rock guitar with cascading synths. The pace is quickened a bit on "I Come Out Fighting," a strident cut encouraging commitment to the "battle."

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CHART WATCH

Adult Contemporary

Freshman Reunion artist Kim Hill scores a #1 song with her first single offering as "Faithful" narrowly claims the top position after just four weeks on the chart. Veteran act Mylon & Broken Heart pulls a strong #2 with "Again and Again," only 12 points behind after its sixth charting week. Kim Boyce's "You Can Be Mine" advances one position to #4 after stalling at #5 for the last two periods. Artists who attain significant forward progress include Steve Camp, Larry Bryant, Allies, and Paul Smith. Both 2nd Chapter of Acts' "Take It to All the World" and Billy Sprague's "I Call It Love" debut within the top 20 while music vet Mark Farner debuts with his initial AC cut, "Isn't It Amazing."

Inspirational

Finishing with not quite the margin of victory as last time (but close), Sandi Patti's "Make His Praise Glorious" reigns comfortably atop *Inspirational* for the third straight period. Meanwhile, John Michael Talbot's debut from his latest squeaks out a #2 finish as "One Faith" comes in less than two points ahead of Buddy Greene's "Virtuous Woman." Twila Paris' "Send Me" moves up seven positions to #5, while the other top 10 big advancer, Glad's "A Mighty Fortress," makes an eight-placement leap to #8. David & Lisa Binion's latest debut, "Caught Up," is the highest new entry as newcomer and AC topper Kim Hill quietly appears at #25 with "Faithful."

Contemporary Hits

Russ Taff notches his second straight period at #1 as "Believe in Love" extends a significant lead over the second place finisher—this time out Kim Boyce's "I Just Want to Celebrate." Last period's AC chart topper "Friend in You" by Jon Gibson, and Sheila Walsh's "Jesus Loves the Church" finish with identical scores. Gibson comes out on top, though, because his cut found its way on to one more playlist than the latter's. Rick Cua's "Forever Yours" leaps a full 10 positions to settle within the top 5, as a host of new entries stake their claim—including debut releases from new Christian artists Kim Hill and Mark Farner.

Rock

"Won by One" conquers the *Rock* after six weeks, giving Mylon & Broken Heart a #1 with *Face the Music*'s debut rock cut. "A Place to Stand" didn't make it easy for Mylon & Crew, though, as last period's top-cut was only 20 points behind. Cua's "Can't Stand Too Tall" moves up 7 positions to #3, as Russ Taff's follow-up to "Shake" "Living on the Edge of Time" advances 5 to #7. The most significant forward progress is made by new Frontline act Shout, as their self-titled debut cut moves up 11 to #11. Last period's top-10 finisher "Your Eyes" by Flock 14, falls off after 8 weeks as The Choir's debut off *Chase the Kangaroo* takes highest new entry honors.
