CBA UNVEILS 'LIFE DISCOVERY' NATIONAL MARKETING PROGRAM

ATLANTA, Ga.--The Christian Booksellers Association (CBA) unveiled its ambitious new national image and marketing program last Wednesday (12) during its 40th Annual International Convention. CBA officials are hoping 'LifeDiscovery' will unite its 3,000-plus member retail stores in the U.S. and more than 750 suppliers in a cooperative marketing, buying and distribution system not unlike those in the hardware (Tru-Value), agriculture (California Raisin Advisory Board) and floral (FTD) industries.

CBA President William R. Anderson said that LifeDiscovery will take Christian retailing into a new era of merchandising, market growth and sales growth. "The time for the LifeDiscovery partnership could not be better," said Anderson during the convention at the Georgia World Congress Center. "Christian retailing is in the midst of consistent growth [see *CCM Update*, July 3, 1989] and LifeDiscovery stores will infuse that growth with the enormous benefit of common knowledge, experience and imagination."

Although the program is not scheduled for its national roll-out until October, 1990, a 16-city test of marketing methods will begin this October. LifeDiscovery training for retailers and suppliers will begin during the CBA regionals in January and February.

The program calls for stores to display the LifeDiscovery logo and signage. LifeDiscovery stores will then benefit from a \$4 million national advertising program, in-store merchandising programs, special training materials, coordinated promotions, local marketing assistance as well as other aspects of the program.

"For suppliers, this will mean that their products will have greater distribution and will be marketed with the highest degree of professionalism and capability available anywhere," said Anderson. Suppliers, who were presented with the program at CBA's annual exhibitor's breakfast, reportedly embraced the concept enthusiastically.

Dan Johnson, a senior marketing consultant to the publishing industry who helped conceive LifeDiscovery, commented: "LifeDiscovery is a promising pivot for an industry which has seen incredible growth but which now needs to take the next step. Numerous other industries have faced similar situations in their maturing. However, the ones which incorporated aggressive and innovative programs like LifeDiscovery went on to flourish."

"Christian retailers couldn't be more excited about LifeDiscovery, because it reflects a definite need in our business as well as a level of market sophistication which we've elevated to," said Paul Herman, chairman of the CBA Board of Directors and a retailer himself. "LifeDiscovery is without a doubt a true partnership uniting publishers, retailers, product manufacturers, and the media into the common good of promoting this industry with sound, innovative business strategy."

Tyndale's Doug Knox, chairman of the CBA Exhibitors Association Board, spoke on behalf of suppliers: "We are optimistic about LifeDiscovery. Specifically for publishers and product manufacturers, LifeDiscovery gives us the critical distribution mechanism we need to penetrate this growing market."

LifeDiscovery was created after several years of strategizing and planning by CBA. The name itself was determined after a lengthy process of creative sessions, pre-testing surveys, and focus groups during which all types of names were considered. According to a CBA brochure about the program, the names needed to be "all-encompassing, inviting, positive and relevant."

CBA is clearly excited about its LifeDiscovery program. As Anderson put it, "Perhaps like never before, people everywhere in our country are looking for answers and as Christian publishers and retailers we have those answers for them. Now, with LifeDiscovery, we have a progressive way of getting those answers to the people. We can now serve the need which so dramatically exists among so many people."

DISTRIBS: CBA SALES REFLECT 'POSITIVE' MOOD OF DEALERS

ATLANTA, Ga.--Reports from the four largest distributors of Christian music toward the end of last week's CBA convention indicated that a strong fall and Christmas season may be ahead. Buoyed by the largest attendance in CBA history (1950 stores, 10,197 total attendance as of last Thursday morning), all four companies reported that sales volume at the convention exceeded last year's. Both Sparrow and Spectra had exceeded last year's volume by the end of the second day.

"The overall attitude of the dealers is real 'up'," said Word Distribution's Tom Ramsey. He reported active business on forthcoming products by Russ Taff, First Call and Michael W. Smith, as well as the multi-artist *Our Hymns* project. Ramsey also said that more than 60 stores ordered the Lift display system for compact discs and cassettes.

He remained jailed as of presstime. His wife Cindy considers him a "political prisoner" and appealed to supporters to voice their opposition to his arrest. Several Christian artists support Operation Rescue. Some, including **Melody Green** and **Glenn Kaiser**, have also been arrested in connection with the organization's pro-life demonstrations....

* **Frank Peretti**, author of the best-selling book, *This Present Darkness*, was presented with a "Gold Book Award" last week by **Amy Grant** on behalf of the publisher, Crossway Books. The special plaque signifies sales of 500,000 units. Peretti's sequel will be released within a month and has a first printing of 300,000 copies....

* **Forefront Communications** has announced the launch of **Yo!Forefront**, a record label committed to rap music. According to a press release, the decision to start a separate label for rap is due to the success of the Forefront group **DC Talk**. A new rap group, **ETW**, has been signed to the new label....

* Have you checked out "Motor of Love" from the latest **Paul McCartney** album? Sample lyric: "My friends keep asking me why/There's such a smile on my face,/There's a home at my place,/Thanks to you. I don't want anything from you,/Turn on your motor of love. Motor of love, motor of love./Heavenly father look down from above./I can't get over your powerful motor of love." Interesting....

* **Integrity Music** has released *Mighty God*, the latest in its praise and worship series. Sales on the line have now reached three million units. In recognition of that accomplishment, Alabama Governor **Guy Hunt** declared July 10 "Integrity Music Day....

* **Frontline** has signed "Mr. Smooth, Mr. Soul Singer, Mr. Songwriter-Producer" **Tim Miner**. Look for his first release with the label next spring....

* **Sparrow Press** is reporting that pre-pub sales on *No Compromise*, the life story of **Keith Green** by Melody Green, are over the 100,000-unit mark....

* **Diadem Music** has announced that it is no longer releasing vinyl radio singles. The change became effective in May....

* The June 12 issue of *Broadcasting* magazine included a format survey which revealed that

"Religious/Gospel" is the third most popular format in terms of number of stations carrying it (1171). Country and Adult Contemporary placed first and second, respectively....

DALLAS, Texas--Word Inc. announced last week that it has acquired Word Records, Limited/Canada, a privately-owned Christian record and book distributor in Vancouver, B.C. It is one of the largest Christian communications companies in Canada.

In announcing the acquisition, Word President Gary Ingersoll said, "While Word's product is a major component of Word Canada's current business, we are particularly pleased, since this acquisition will secure our continued distribution of Word product in Canada and will allow us an increased opportunity for growth in this area. We look forward to continuing our long-standing relationship with everyone at Word Canada."

The company was purchased from Gerry and Janice Scott of Vancouver, who founded it 27 years ago. The purchase price was not disclosed.

In addition to the Word line, Word Ltd. also serves as the Canadian distributor for Sparrow, Reunion, Maranatha! Music, Image 7, Diadem, Bread 'n Honey and others.

PICK OF THE WEEK:

Kim Hill, *Talk About Life* (Reunion)

Hill places herself squarely in the adult rock movement (Sting, Winwood, Brickell, Vega) with her second release. There are a lot of "mores" on this release compared to her debut: more electric (but still acoustic-based); more progressive (one of the most musically challenging and creative productions in the history of contemporary Christian music); more passionate (yes, that gorgeous alto voice got better); and more mature (the songs are vulnerable insights of her spiritual journey). The music may be a bit eclectic/sophisticated and the lyrics too introspective for some of her fans of the first album, but *Talk* is a natural for the female and boomer markets.

Michael Card, *Sleep Sound in Jesus* (Sparrow)

Card has always dreamed of recording an album designed to put you to sleep. Well, this beautiful album of lullabies does just that. Along with Silverwind vocalist Betsy Hernandez, Card employs his sensitive vocals and tender melodies in 17 songs to comfort and teach.

Steve Fry, *They Kingdom Come* (Sparrow)

Rarely in the music world is an album considered a stirring, dramatic experience. Well, here's one. Fry's newest release is similar to a musical soundtrack. The music glides between high church/classical with a Handel-like quality to touching, personal ballads to soft pop. This is a welcome new twist in the praise and worship field.

Jim and Ginger Hendricks, *Running in the Light* (Glory to Glory/Star Song) --With a long list of mainstream pop credits, this husband and wife team direct their talents to the burgeoning praise and worship movement. Their songs are upbeat pop songs with P&W themes. The production blends the songs together for a non-stop worship experience.

Michael Peace, *Vigilante of Hope* (Reunion)

Peace has continually set the standard for the slow-moving Christian rap field. Although his first two releases seem tame today, they were the best at the time. Well, this time Peace takes a quantum leap forward--not only for Christian music but for mainstream rappers as well. Dez Dickerson (Prince's former guitarist) not only proves to be a brilliant producer, but injects Peace and his music with the necessary grit, aggressiveness, and harder edge. On top of that, Dickerson infuses a sophistication and funkiness rarely heard in the genre. The Prince/Minneapolis sound dominates throughout. The lyrics are still all Michael Peace. His in-your-face, turn-or-burn approach is hard-core, inner city evangelism at its best.

Sparks, *Sparks* (Reunion)

Greg and Rebecca Sparks' (another husband and wife duo) debut release does not mean they are newcomers. They are former members of Found Free, Bash N' the Code and, most recently, the Russ Taff band. Their music is power grass-roots rock with a delta feel driven by Rebecca's powerhouse voice. This experienced duo's songwriting and performance talents really shine on their first release.

Gerald Wolfe, *Hold Forth the Light* (Benson)

Wolfe's second release continues to solidify his position as the baritone of inspirational music. That big, unforgettable voice in the small package does justice to ten tunes written by some of the best. His duet with Joy Gardner ("No Wonder") ranks up there with "I've Just Seen Jesus."

David Zaffiro, *The Other Side* (Alarma)

This is Zaffiro's debut since leaving Bloodgood as their lead guitarist. His expert guitar abilities and crunch are showcased here, as well as his songwriting. The music is hard rock with loads of polish for today's pop metal crowd.

PICKS OF THE WEEK:

Steve Camp, "Living Dangerously in the Hands of God" (Sparrow) --This stately piece from the *Justice* project finds Camp waging an inner war against a complacent faith. Deep synth shadings are offset by regal piano play.

Morgan Cryar, "The Voice of Experience," w/ "I'm Still Dangerous" (Reunion) CD --First cuts from Cryar's newest release--after a three year break--show the radio-ready, commercial appeal of his earlier projects. The A-cut encourages the listener to hearken to "The Voice of Experience," amidst smoothly rolling synths and sprinklings of light percussion and guitar. The loosely bound sass and punch of "I'm Still Dangerous" should yield a favorable reception at *Rock*.

Mylon & Broken Heart, "Movin' On," w/ "Turn the Tables" (Star Song) CD --These guys can be so smooth sometimes; "Movin' On" demonstrates that velvet touch in its first-person recountal of a life of faith. Mylon's bid at tortured vocal angst on "Turn the Tables" is even smooth--effective nonetheless, though, as the band's pulsating rock accompaniment fleshes out a track which personalizes Jesus' cleansing of the temple.

White Heart, "Eighth Wonder," b/w "Invitation" (Sparrow) 12" --The cross-format lack of success of "The River Will Flow" (save #1 accomplishments at CHR), gave *Freedom* a less-than spectacular opening crack at radio--a fact that should change with these target releases. "Eighth Wonder" is an appealing cut showing a strong vocal hook and high melodic appeal, while "Invitation" demonstrates the band's inventive flair--even including a free-form scat/bass sequence.

Noteworthy

Altar Boys, "Forever Mercy," w/ "The Meaning of Life" (Alarma) 12" --The Boys encounter a flawed world on these debut cuts from *Forever Mercy*--albeit a world with a Hope. "Forever Mercy" is a rousing, hard-driving cut which proffers a merciful, loving approach to life. A similar theme of compassion is expressed on "The Meaning of Life"--showing an open, less aggressive music mix.

Michael Card, "Live This Mystery" (Sparrow) *Album Cut* Intimate ballad shows Card the poet/lyricist considering the unfathomable aspects of life in Christ. Tempered, but well-crafted instrumentation allows the beauty of the verse to be considered.

Mike Eldred, "Ready to Fly," w/ "I Open My Heart" (Home Sweet Home) CD --The former Truth vocalist finds the formula on these two debuts from his first solo release, *Uncommon Love*. The tight, pop production on "Ready to Fly" provides an amply upbeat backdrop for the artist's emotive vocal performance, while on the spacious "I Open My Heart," Eldred shows himself an earnest inspirational performer.

Prism, "Wonderful Words of Life" (Reunion) CD This new cut follows the established Prism form, and therefore fits well amidst the group's previously recorded material on *The Hits*--a new Prism "best-of" collection. A church favorite bathed in the splashings of modern music production.

David Zaffiro, "I See Red" (Alarma) *Album Cut* Zaffiro trots onto the solo artist scene after already establishing himself as the ace Christian metal guitarist with the oh so popular Frontline metal act, Bloodgood. Here indeed, the artist proves his guitar can spring and snarl with the best of them, and demonstrates a keen pop-metal vocal ability ta-boot.

Top Albums

Freedom makes a big 15 point jump, from last month's debut of #16, to become the industry's top-seller in its second month of release. White Heart's latest led the second place entry, Sandi Patti's *Friendship Company*, by a 20% margin. The chart's longest running entry (at 71 months and counting), and last month's sales leader—Patti's *More Than Wonderful*—falls to #3. Larnelle Harris' latest, *I Can Begin Again*, leads this period's new entries at #13, followed on down the chart by Deniece Williams' *Special Love* (18); Hosanna's *Bless the Lord* (26); Farrell & Farrell's *Superpower* (36); Altar Boys' *Forever Mercy* (38); a new Brentwood project, *Follow the Son* (45); and Mastedon's debut LP, *It's a Jungle Out There* (48).

Adult Contemporary

"Healing," the first release from Deniece Williams' fast selling *Special Love*, claims top honors here after only four charting weeks, pacing itself ahead of Bryan Duncan's "Strong Medicine" by a moderate 30 points. Last week's leader, "Jesus, It's You," falls to #3. Big movers include Wayne Watson's "The Long Arm of the Lord" (advancing nine to #9); D&K's debut from *The Pledge*, "If God Is for Us" (up 12 to #11); Kim Boyce's first release from *Love Is You to Me*, "For Every Lonely Heart" (up 12 to #15); and Newsong's "Love Is" (up 12 to #18). New entries were had by Twila Paris, David & the Giants, Farrell & Farrell, Wendy Foy, Allies, and Phil Madeira.

Inspirational

Ray Boltz's "Shepherd Boy" takes top honors after its fourth charting week, giving the artist his second *Inspirational* #1 from *Thank You*—the album's title-cut reached the same plateau late last year. Larnelle Harris' "I Can Begin Again" and Steven Curtis Chapman's "His Strength Is Perfect" retain #2 and #3 respectively, just ahead of the enormous chart climbing accomplishments of Sandi Patti's "That's the Love of God"—advancing 21 positions to #4. "Unconditional Love," by Terri Gibbs, gains eight positions to settle in the top-5, while Steve Green's "Praise You, I Will Praise You" makes a seven point advancement to just make the top-10. The following artists debuted: Chris & Diane Machen, Geoffrey Benward, Deniece Williams, Newsong, and the Hosanna Singers.

Contemporary Hits

Kim Boyce makes a quick order out of placing "For Every Lonely Heart" as the top CHR cut, after it debuted just last week at #7. A couple of big advancers in the top-5: Deniece Williams' "Healing" (up seven to #3) and Benny Hester's "Perfect" (up seven to #4). Lots of new entries including cuts by Paul Smith, Jon Gibson, Farrell & Farrell, Mastedon, Jerome Olds, and Bash 'N' the Code.

Rock

"I Can, I Will" holds its own at #1, giving Rick Cua his second consecutive chart-topping period. Phil Keaggy's "Big Eraser" gained steam at #6 for two periods, apparently in preparation for a four point advance to #2 this week. Barren Cross marks a seven point gain with a top-5 placing, as DeGarmo & Key advance a full 16 placements to halt at #6. Rez's "You Get What You Choose" makes it 18 consecutive charting weeks.
